

Horeke has no food Tour companies could provide a packed lunch(at a cost) for cyclists to enjoy at end of trail at the stunning setting of the Mangugnu Mission House

We would like to have ridden further than what we did but we needed to turn around to get back to our vehicles. The cost of shuttles for cyclists is prohibitive. This means you can only do a portion of the trail at any one time rather than completing coast to coast.

It would have been good to have a few more seats in shaded areas to stop and have a drink and snack. The squeeze bars were a bit of a pain but we did realise that it stopped our bums being numb by having to get off and on the bike so many

Nothing to offer as it is everything that could be expected.

Food and drink place at Horeke.

The cafe owner at okaihau was not friendly and welcoming. We left before puchasing anything.
